

DDP with Computer Science – Integrated Honours Project Workflow

Students reading a Double Degree with Computer Science and who wish to work on an Integrated Honours Project should follow the procedure below in proposing a project:

1. Student would look for a main supervisor from the home department and discuss with him/her about the project proposal. The project content should include substantial content involving both disciplines.
2. At the same time, the student is also responsible for finding a consenting co-supervisor from the secondary department. But if the main supervisor holds a joint appointment in Mathematics and Computer Science, then it would not be necessary to find a co-supervisor from the secondary department.
3. Both main and co-supervisors have to agree, in writing, to supervise the student's honours project – an email would suffice.
4. Upon confirming the project proposal and supervisors, student would submit a copy of the project proposal and supervision consent to the home department for review and approval. Once the home department approves the proposal, it would be routed to the secondary department for review.
5. Once the secondary department has approved the proposal, student would be informed of the outcome by the home department, and project work may begin.
6. Student and supervisors will adhere to the project work schedule and assessment guidelines of the student's home department. Student would also be preallocated with the home department's project module code.
